Purpose:

- This script simplifies the setup of surface sources in Speos.
 - It saves time and reduces risk of manual errors during the workflow.

Functionality:

The script performs the following actions:

1. User can setup parametrized source positions (sensor diagonal, azimuth and elevation angle and intermediate steps).
2. User can define target area illumination diameter and illuminance.

Installation:
